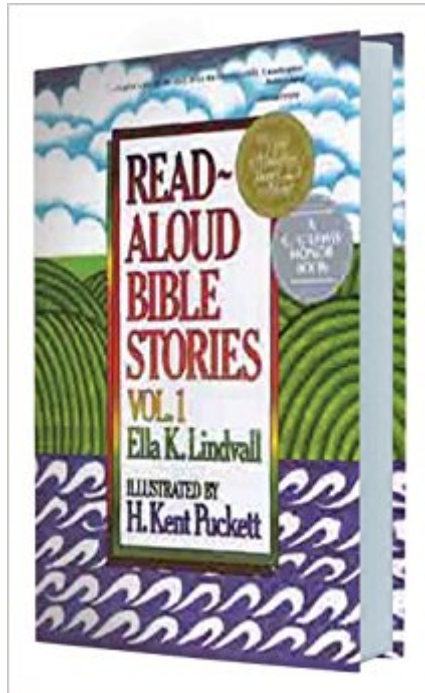




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Read Aloud Bible Stories: Volume 1

Ella K. Lindvall has taught primary school in the United States and internationally. She's the author of The Bible Illustrated for Little Children, My Friend Jesus, and The People of the Bible Series.

ELLA K. LINDVALL is a mother and former elementary school teacher. She spent 20 years teaching Kindergarten, first, and second grades in Taiwan, the United Arab Emirates, and the United States. Ella is a skilled children's editor and writer, and served until retirement as the managing editor for Moody Publishers. Among her many children's books are The Bible in Pictures for Toddlers and the acclaimed Read-Aloud Bible Stories series, the first volume of which is an ECPA Gold Medallion winner and C.S. Lewis Honor Book. Ella and her husband, Andrew, reside near Chicago, Illinois.

This isn't a review, but rather information on how to find Volumes 1, 2 & 3 of this series on Amazon. I first tried to find them by searching for both the titles and the author's name, and the only volumes I could find were Vols 1 & 4. Finally, I got the ISBN numbers for Vols 2 & 3 off another website and searched for them on Amazon and voila, the books came up. So, if you want Vol 2, then do an Amazon search for: 9780802471642 and if you want Vol 3, search for: 9780802471659. The books ARE available on Amazon, they're just tricky to find, at least as of today - hopefully Amazon will fix that soon. In case you're having trouble finding Vol 1 (you have to enter the complete title exactly correctly), the ISBN for that is 9780802471635.

Good book, not as many stories as I would have liked but I guess that's why there is 3 volumes. The language is great for 3 year olds and the pictures are good. The stories may be a little short but that depends on the child. Good book overall and we are planning on purchasing the others as well soon.

The Read Aloud Bible Story series is amazing. If you are a parent or a Bible class teacher, you need to get this set. You will not regret it, it is worth every penny you spend. My daughter is now 24 years old, so I have used these books for over 20 years. They are still in good condition and you never tire of the stories. You can tell that the author is a person who has told Bible stories to young children for years. Very Biblical, but simplified for children to understand. The artwork to go along

with the stories is wonderful, very creative way of showing the story and the impact of what happened in the story. Perfect for preschoolers, but even elementary aged children will be engaged with a wonderfully told story.

My adult son's favorite storybook when he was little so I bought it for him to read to his new son.

I purchased this book and Vol 2 when my kids were little and now I'm giving them to my grandchildren. What's great about these books are the pictures are big and colorful for a young child's attention and the story is short and accurate.

I gave Vol. 1 and 2 as a gift. The person who received them was familiar with the series. She likes that the pictures are large and colorful and there are fewer words on a page than in other books. These characteristics are a help in holding children's attention. I think she is a qualified judge. She has a Master of Education and teaches Special Education in elementary school. She also teaches three-year-olds in Sunday School "...they're fun.".

These Bible stories are the best children's Bibles Stories I have found. The pictures are clear and the writing is concise and easy for children to grasp. There is great emotion expressed in this book regarding the love of Jesus toward people. It is a wonderful book that children actually like reading. I have read it to my children and now grandchildren. Other children's bible books are too long or if they are short stories they leave out important points. This book has all the right components. If you really want your children to understand God and Jesus's love for them THIS IS THE BOOK.

I have had these books for both of my children when they were toddlers; they are now 26 and 31. I purchased an entire set for each of them for their children, and I have now given these to my niece, who is expecting. These books are unique in that they allow each child to imagine what Jesus looks like; they also allow them to see the gratitude for what He has done for people during His ministry. I love, love, love, this series and would highly recommend it to those who want to present the bible stories in a way that is fun and interactive, and which provokes discussion at the end of each! The pictures are bold and just perfect for the young reader.

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
