She was kinda like a third "sibling" if you will. The boys took it extremely hard when Fifers died. So, after looking through the endless lists of books - I found "For Every Dog an Angel". (There are other books out there but, for two little boys they wanted something simple. They wanted to make sure their Fifers was taken care of. This book did it. So when the dog comes to the end of its earthly life and must go on ahead without its person beside them, the guardian angel becomes a loving bridge that connects the two friends for as long as the person remains on earth." and the one the boys loved the most: "So don't be surprised to see your new dog racing through the house as if it's playing with an invisible friend... it probably is."
