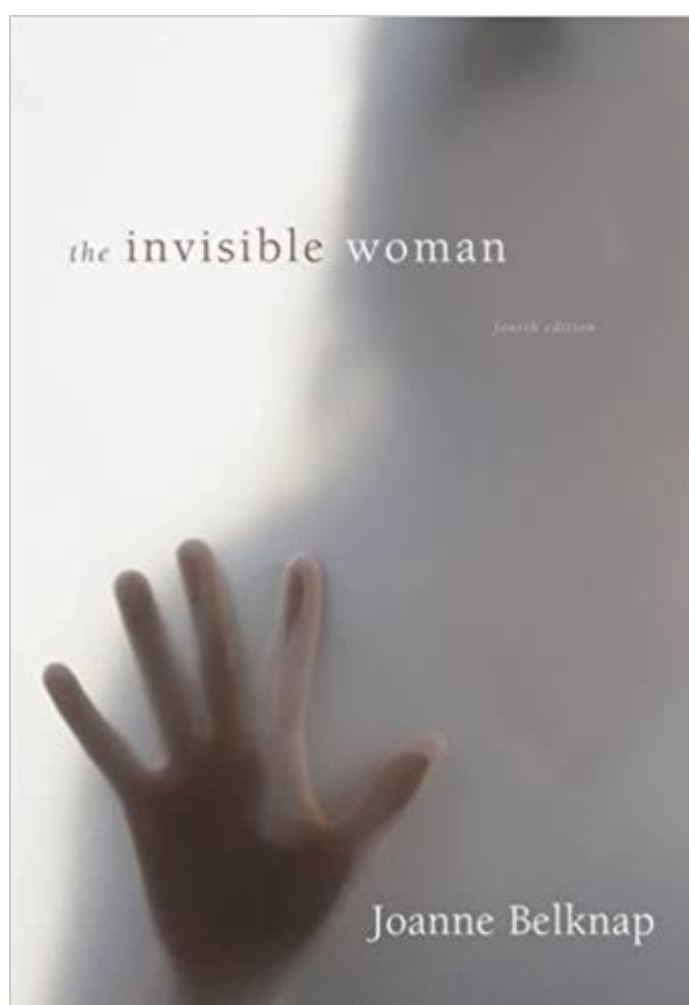


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The Invisible Woman: Gender, Crime, And Justice (Wadsworth Contemporary Issues In Crime And Justice)
