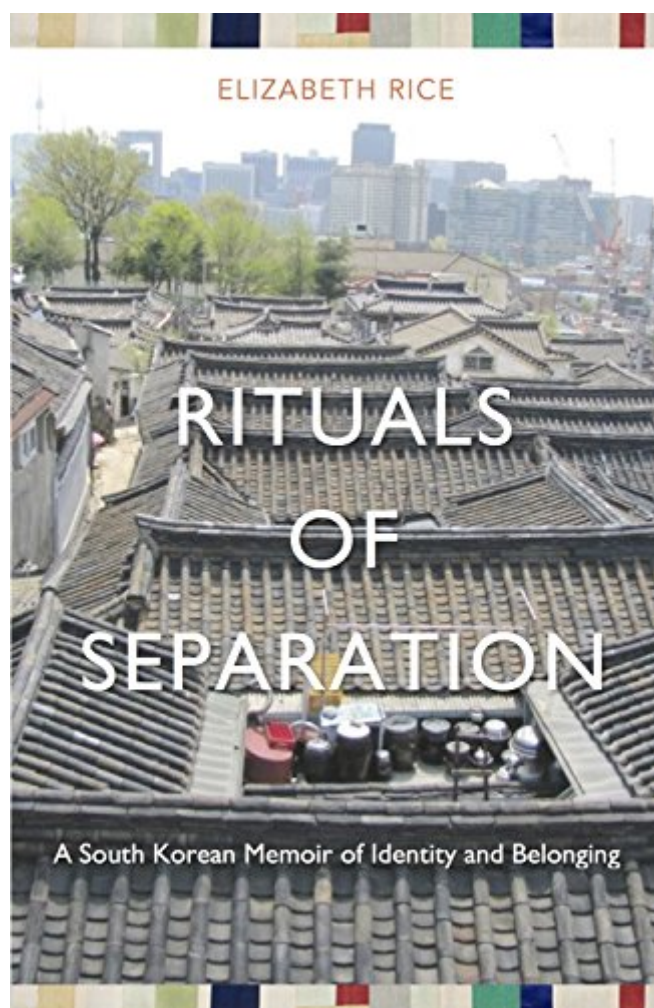

When her American family returns to the U.S. after sixteen years in South Korea, Liz is a hidden immigrant. Her mixed-up cultural identity is veiled behind the face of the girl down the street. She's the granddaughter of upperclass Americans, but her homeland is a divided Asian peninsula of neon-lit cities, five-hundred-year-old palaces, and army dictators. Rice tells the story of her life in South Korea from ages nine months to sixteen, the influence of the tragedy and tension of the Korean peninsula, and the story of her parents, who walked arm-in-arm with social activists during South Korea's democratic revolution. Told with honesty and humor, *Rituals of Separation* captures the tension of living between identities, the deep longing for home, and the determination to find healing in the face of unrecoverable loss.

A beautifully written memoir about transitions and belonging. People who have lived internationally, especially as children, will appreciate the author's description of sorrow and loss of culture and community. Knowing someone else has gone through the transition, will help others through the

grief process.

Having lived in Korea during the time period of this book, I had never given much thought to how growing up in a foreign land must impact our children. This insightful, beautifully-written, moving account of Elizabeth's young years taught me much about a child's perspective and experience of living in Korea (or in any other foreign land) -- especially the challenge of adapting to life in the U.S., her "home" country, when it doesn't really feel like home. The reality of having to emotionally straddle two cultures, described so eloquently in this book, gave me a completely new appreciation for what so many expat kids must go through. A true page-turner, I could almost "taste" the sights, smells and rich beauty of this small but vibrant country, once again.
