This book is less educational than I'd like - more like a collection of factoids. The book is of the same quality you'd expect from National Geographic in terms of the pictures, etc., just not quite what I was looking for.

So we bought this for our daughter 2 years ago when she was 8, and she still rereads it (was doing so again today actually). So I asked her today about it, because it seems to have had remarkable staying power for her. She says she loves the pictures, and she really loves the section on tornadoes a lot. She says she does wish it had a little bit more information on them, but that she wouldn't reduce the rating for that. There have been no problems with the binding, or any other aspect of the book, which is awesome because she hasn't quite acquired my gentle touch with books yet.

As a teacher, I wanted a book which describes basic weather events with large clear pictures. This book is filled with many weather factoids with smaller photos that splash over the page in a hyper (exciting?) way. One child might enjoy the hyped up presentation but its impossible to show a class pages filled with small photos and CAPITAL LETTER!!! texts that will "blow your mind"!!!

This was purchased for my 12 year old son. He loves reading the stories, looking at the colorful pictures which he feels that is exciting and cool.
