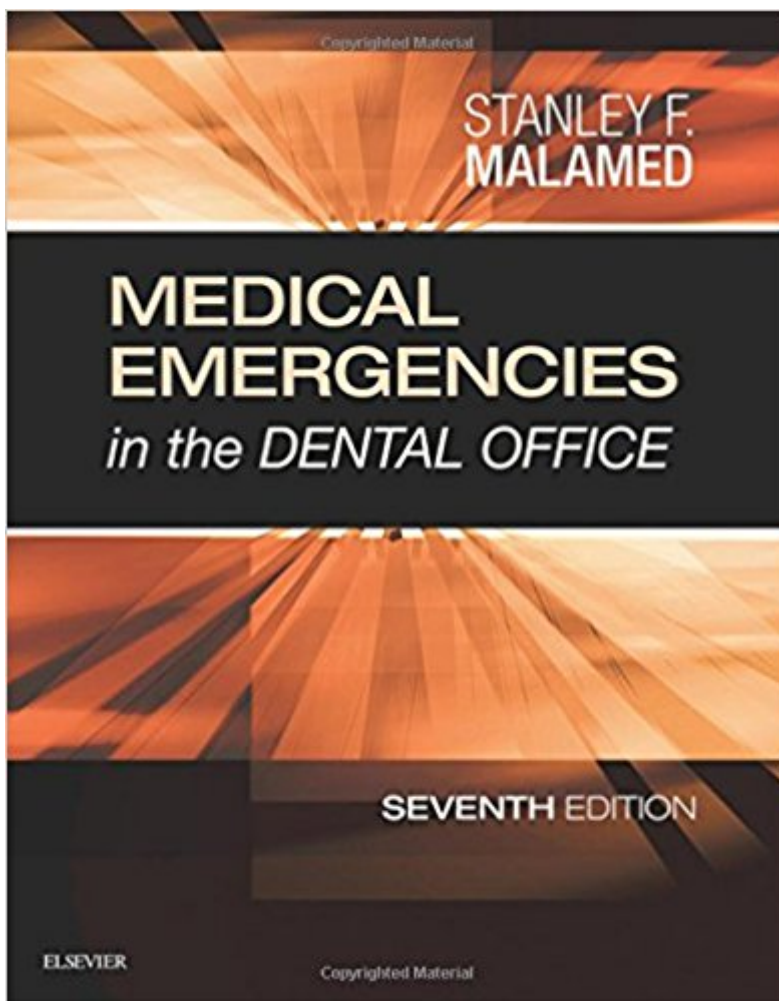

Pros:-This is the gold standard book on the topic from a very thoughtful author who communicates a dry subject in an interesting and informative way. Cons:-The appendix is NOT included. The description doesn't tell you this. The appendix is a quick reference guide for emergencies. The appendix is one of the most useful parts of the book.-The tables are scanned at too low of a resolution and are unreadable for me (using the Kindle app on a Windows RT tablet)
