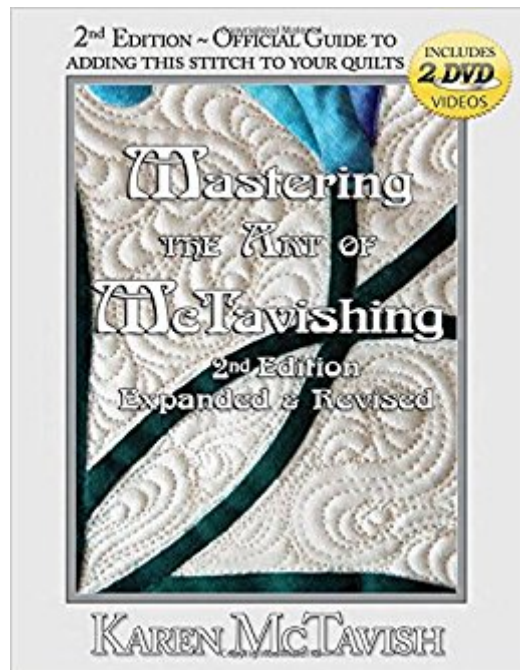

This edition boasts revised how-to chapters, new graphics, new text, and a simpler teaching method.
