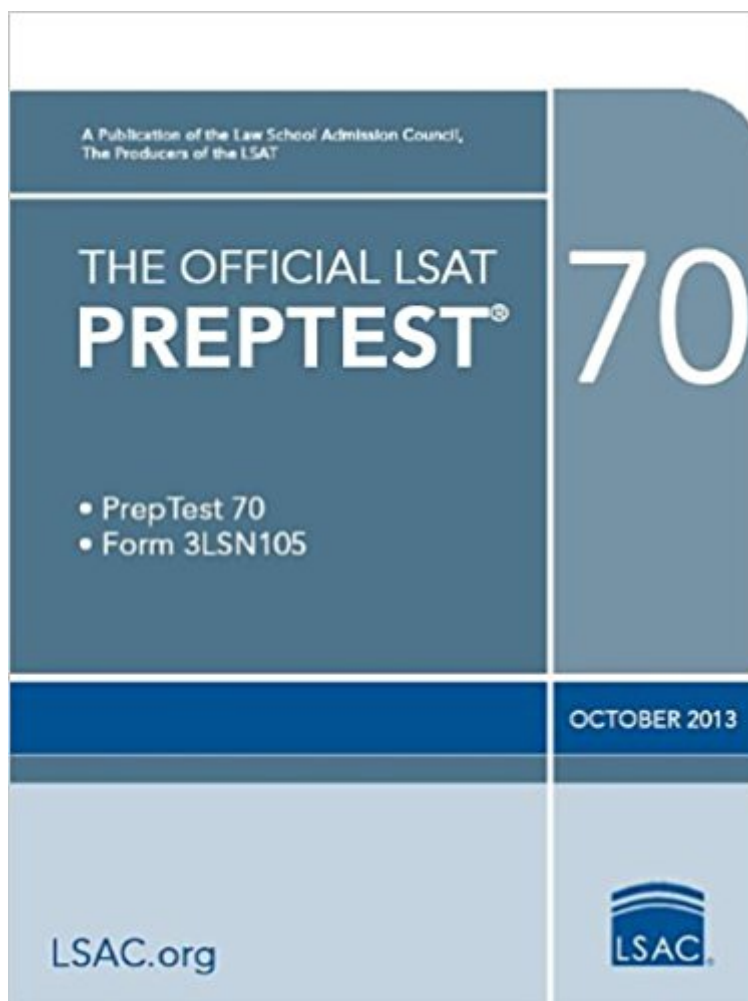

The Law School Admission Council has developed and administered the LSAT on behalf of all American Bar Association-approved law schools since 1948. Their national headquarters are located in Newtown, PA.

This is the newest LSAT pretest, as of the time of this review (Dec 2013). The LSAT changes with time. You should definitely get the newest test, as new tests are the best indicator of what future tests will look like. Considering how important the LSAT is to your odds of admission, this book is well worth the price. You should also get the following books: LSATs 52-61, LSAT 62, LSAT 63, LSAT 64, LSAT 65, LSAT 66, LSAT 67, LSAT 68, LSAT 69. The total cost of those books + this book is around \$80-\$90. You'll get 19 of the most recent, official LSAT pretests. There is no better investment you could make towards a better LSAT score. Note that only LSAT 70 (this test), LSAT 69, LSAT 68, LSAT 67 and LSAT 66 have two pages for logic games diagrams. I recommend using only the

second page for your diagrams. I've watched students draw diagrams far away from the questions, and it is surprisingly easy to lose your train of thought when you have to move your eyes across multiple pages. Graeme Blake Author of *LSAT 70 Explanations*

Having never before seen a LSAC preptest before, I was surprised by the thinness of the booklet. This is literally just a re-print of an exam in a newsprint paper material. The cheapness of the newsprint material does not bother me, as I am paying for the ink on the paper instead of the paper itself.

I greatly enjoyed Prep Test 70. The examination draws on many elements common to the genre, but adds a provocative spin that I think really tapped into the format's potential. I would love to see future tests exhibit the same daring. Bravo!

As expected

This is currently the newest LSAT PrepTest (as of early December 2013). Since the LSAT evolves over time, it's important to practice with the most recent exams. LSAT PrepTests 66-70 are currently the only exams that have the 2-page layout for Logic Games. Before this, each exam only gave you a single page for each Logic Game and related questions. (I've published images of the new layout on my blog. You can see the relevant post by clicking the "Logic Games" heading at the top.) Aside from this exam, I'd also recommend getting: LSAT PrepTest 62 (Dec. 2010 LSAT) LSAT PrepTest 63 (Jun. 2011 LSAT) LSAT PrepTest 64 (Oct. 2011 LSAT) LSAT PrepTest 65 (Dec 2011 LSAT) LSAT PrepTest 66 (Jun. 2012 LSAT) LSAT PrepTest 67 (Oct. 2012 LSAT) LSAT PrepTest 68 (Dec. 2012 LSAT) LSAT PrepTest 69 (Jun. 2013 LSAT) Unfortunately, 62-69 are not yet sold in a book of 10, which makes them significantly more expensive than others. For additional, more affordable practice, you can get LSATs 29-38 and 52-61 in books of 10. LSAC has allowed LSATs 39-51 to go out of print, but you can purchase PDFs of these exams through my website.

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
