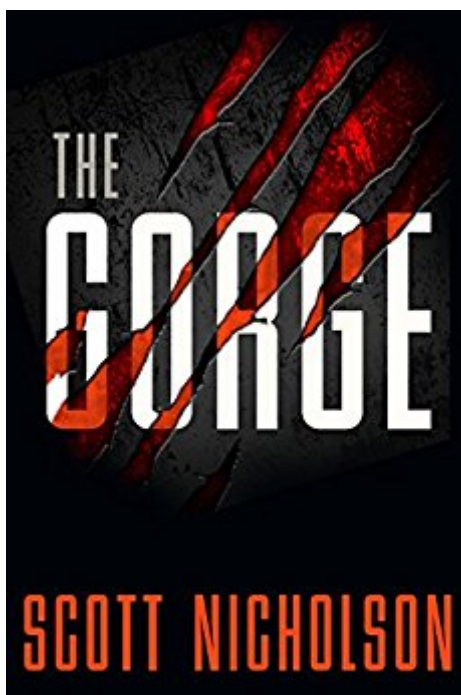

The Gorge has its creepy moments, but Nicholson doesn't give us anyone to really care about. In addition to a not so sympathetic lead whose false sense of guilt turns into a reclusive boar; a beautiful younger woman who loves him but no back story about the relationship; a stereotypical bully/coward, a corporate shill and famous cyclist who are only in the story a kill fodder, and a Native American athlete who gets most of the author's attention but who is basically an empty shell-essentially a junkie with no substantial character. Overall, it was alright but far from a great read. Red Church was much better.

This book felt like Deliverance with a supernatural twist. I really liked it. A little more gore than my usual reading, but a thrilling horror tale.
