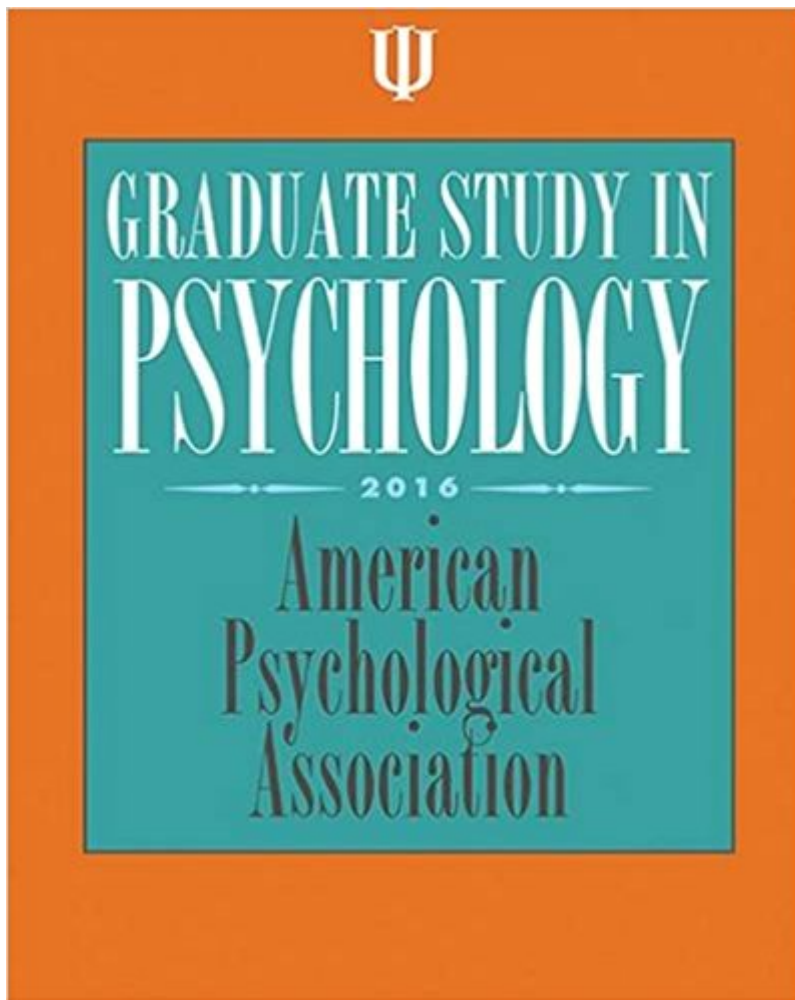

This book is okay. Nice indexed format, sorted by state so you can see which graduate programs in psychology are available in each state. Includes great info like acceptance rates, statistics on applicants - numbers, races, genders, etc., various specialties, internships available, tuition, etc. and all in a clear, easy-to-grasp format. The only problem is that it doesn't include all programs. For some reason, Princeton and Bellevue were at least two schools not included. That really sucked. So while this is a great book for programs that are featured, note that it does not include all programs available.

Wow, does this book suck. It's convenient to have all the information in front of you, but on more than one occasion this book has been wrong. Mostly about what degree the university offers, or it will state that X-university offers a degree that it doesn't. Really annoying because it often doesn't even provide all the information (such as GPA requirements) so you have to go to the school websites and dig for it, only to find out that school doesn't offer that degree. This sounds like a really petty problem that takes 5 minutes, BUT when you're looking at multiple schools it's a huge waste of your time. I was looking for educational psychology and school psychology (phD and masters) - so if you're on the same track, take note of this. It's good to get you started but not anywhere near how much it costs since so much of the information is wrong. I'll be returning it. #Frustratedstudent

Schools are organized by state, and alphabetically in each state chapter, and each school with Psychology programs states what programs they have, and requirements to get into those programs. You can also search in the back to see what universities offer the program you're looking for. I'm very glad I bought it, and would recommend it to those seriously looking into graduate psychology programs. I would also say maybe wait until your Junior

year to get it, so you can have an up to date version, but I would also say don't wait until your senior year, because it has information that's helpful to have before you send out your applications, like GRE-V score requirements, and things like that.
