

We wrote Scrolls of Zndaria: The Golden Wizard because we wanted children to know that anything is possible. Nate wants to be a wizard in a world where only nobility are selected to study magic. He is a peasant. He is bullied and ridiculed by many of the children of the town's nobility. Even his parents tell him it is a foolish dream. He must overcome this intolerance in order to accomplish his dream. Scrolls of Zndaria: The Golden Wizard is the first in a seven-book series. The next four books each introduce a new hero that will join Nate. Each book presents a different set of challenges that, just like in real life, each hero must conquer in order to complete their personal quests. The final two books require these five unlikely young heroes to overcome prejudices in order to work together as a team if they are to save the world of Zndaria. --This text refers to the Hardcover edition.

A book for all ages written for younger readers but enjoyable to all. A fantastical journey into the land of Zndaria where the heroes learn to face challenges in a mystical world but learn lessons adaptable to real life through their journeys. It deals with bullying, class discrimination, and overcoming the injustices of the world all while flying on a pegasus. The characters make friends with elves and deal with gnomes, mothers, and brothers. The tale is well written and easy to read while retaining a depth of meaning hard to find in children's literature.
