This, the third book in the series lost a bit of the excitement of new travels and some new travelers. I have not yet re-read to see if I could find my "area" of disinterest or if I misread a phrase, but I will. The twists and turns within the story still want the reader to forge ahead to something new, yet going to fast may make you miss something important. It's a very compelling ongoing tale. Each of these books can stand alone, but by reading in order lets the reader keep track of important episodes in this fable and does help the story line to pop all the bubbles that make the excitement flow.

When an author uses a cliffhanger in a series, the reader should be able to expect a reasonably quick response in the next episode. When titling chapters for a series that may require review of previously read chapters, due to the length of time between publications, it is helpful to use memorable chapter headings - not merely numbered progression. The stories overall are compelling, characters are believable, the world building nicely thought out.

This is a fairly good series. It's not GRRM level, but the story certainly is compelling and it is good enough to make you want to stick around till the end. The characters are fairly well-developed, and though the story is somewhat predictable, you still have questions that have not yet been answered. I'm looking forward to the next book in the series. The one problem with it is it needs editing, badly. There are many grammar and spelling errors throughout the entire series. That's the reason for the loss of one star on this review.
