

While it is true that the original volume 1 violin work has a part 1 and 2 in it, it is normally not described that way, because it can be confused with volume 1 & 2, which are two separate volumes. This misleading description plus the fact that this is really just volume 1 plus a few paltry double stop scales, a poor substitute for the comprehensive double and multiple stops material from volume 2, is the reason why I took out two stars, in spite of the fact there is apparently no similar Galamian alternative available for viola (yet the cello version is complete!!). The original is comprehensive for a reason, no need to leave anything out!! I am considering transcribing volume 2 myself for my own personal use, though it would be nice if I could just buy it.
