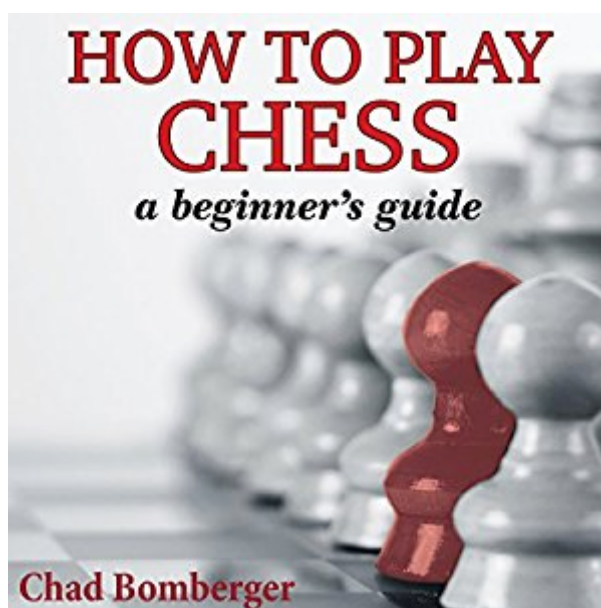

A chess book without diagrams is unusual. This book has none, but the author does a good job of

creating word pictures. It is a good introduction to the game of chess that is unfortunately marred by errors large and small. Errors include presenting speculative history as well established. The exact origins of chess are not known with certainty, but Chad Bomberger offers a plausible account. Errors about how to play are more serious. The author states that you may not check the opponent when you are in check. There is no such rule. The rule is that you must get out of check. One way to do so is blocking. If this blocking action unleashes a discovered check, then you have proven Bomberger wrong. The most popular colors of the dark squares on a chess board are green and brown, not black. The author should use the terms dark and light, rather than black and white. I could list about a dozen more small errors. Bomberger writes well enough that he would have a good book if he would invest the time to correct these errors.

I have been playing chess for many years and frequently make efforts to improve my strategy. This book was layed out very efficiently and had excellent content for both beginners and seasoned chess players as well. I bought it browsing through ebooks one day and I am very glad I did. Excellent book to learn or improve your chess skills!

I have always wanted to learn chess, but wasn't able to find a website that explained it clearly. It is meant for beginners and it really has improved my knowledge and I get general play. Good purchase.
