

concept of "Imagineering". Combining their Hollywood skills with Engineering know how to create their amazing parks and attractions. The level of detail in the book is astounding. It gives great info on how everything is examined. Everything is deliberately designed. Everything serves and tells a story. The book is packed full of amazing art, concept art, various protected fold outs and brochures. Just a true masterpiece. It will keep you fascinated for years. The only downside is the bulk of this book is really focused on the 1980's to the present designs. There is some historical stuff, but not as much as you might like. All of that can be largely found in the prior book on Imagineering, which is sadly out of print, hard to find and expensive.

I am an avid collector of Disney art books, and an art school graduate. Of all the books I have, this one should be a mandatory addition in the library of any art student or creative person. It is a heavy hardcover book with plenty of fold out pages. The details of this book provide endless inspiration and it covers a wide array of themes unlike other books that focus in on a particular subject/ride/story/character. If you only get one Disney themed art book, this is the best one.

My nephew is majoring in engineering and hopes to one day become an Imagineer. Last summer we were lucky enough to attend lunch with an Imagineer, and she told us so many wonderful "behind the scenes" stories. This book is like that lunch, only longer and illustrated.
