

This is a supplement to the much larger *Pharmacotherapy* textbook by DiPiro. I'm in pharmacy school and to have the information distilled down to just the information I need instead of useless factoids is priceless. If you're taking a class and have the textbook as assigned reading, don't even bother buying it. Buy this in its place. The chapter's don't correlate exactly to the big book, but the index is very thorough and it's easy to find what you're looking for.

I originally purchased this as a supplement in pharmacy school which is nice if you're looking for basic information. However, if you're serious about getting into pharmacotherapy or anything slightly in depth in terms of therapy, this book only skims the surface. Plus many schools nowadays have access to up-to-date and other drug references which give more in-depth answers along with literature to back it up. I barely touched this book purchasing it.

I am a pharmacist who has been out of school for more than 7 years. I bought this book in hopes it would be a good concise review, since I feel like I have forgotten a lot specific disease state information that I learned in school. This book is well organized, but in general I have found it difficult to use for learning. I think this book assumes that you already have a pretty good knowledge

of diseases, and uses terminology that is sometimes beyond what I remember. I also feel like it doesn't go into as much detail as I would like for drug recommendations and dosings. Overall, I would not buy again. If you're still in school, this would probably be a great concise book to use along with your big Dipiro. But for someone like me, whose disease knowledge isn't as strong as it used to be, this book is just frustrating.
