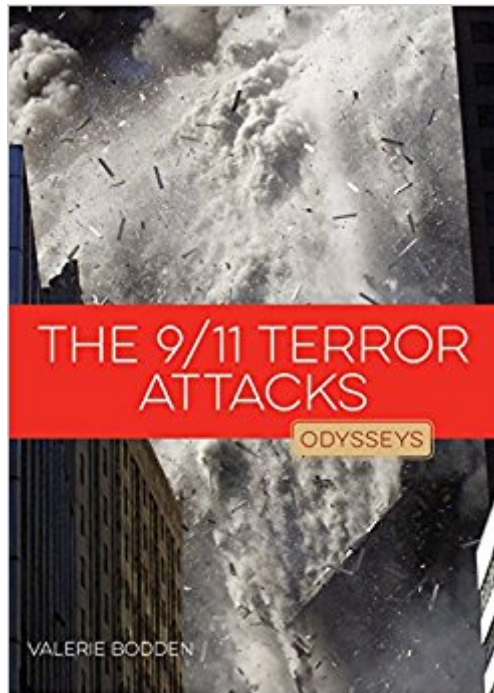

Gr 7 Up-Previously published as the "Days of Change" (Creative Education) series nearly a decade ago, this set has been reformatted into a more attractive layout. However, content and illustrations are almost completely unchanged, with the exception of The 9/11 Attacks, which adds a few sentences about the Iraq War, the Patriot Act, and the death of Osama bin Laden. Content doesn't venture beyond what is generally standard for these topics, and analysis and interpretations as well as bibliographies and recommended sources are becoming dated. There are numerous extant titles about these subjects, many written since these books were originally published. VERDICT Libraries that need material about these topics should consider more recent treatments for reports and readers. (c) Copyright 2011.
