TEAGAN WHITE is a freelance designer and illustrator from Chicago, now living and working in Minnesota, where she earned her BFA in Illustration from the Minneapolis College of Art & Design. Her work encompasses intricate drawings of flora and fauna, playful watercolors of anthropomorphic critters, illustrated typography, and everything in between. Teagan lives in the woods across the street from train tracks and a fox den, and spends her free time scolding neighborhood squirrels, exploring forests, rivers, lakes, and swamps, picking wildflowers, and collecting animal bones. Adventures with Barefoot Critters was her first picture book; the Critters return in Counting With Barefoot Critters. The author lives in St. Paul, Minnesota.

Great book! So much to see and talk about on each page. My daughter (23 months) makes us flip back and forth between the pages to look at her favorites over and over again (she especially likes the mouse sleeping in the hammock). It's not the best, best book for learning the alphabet but I wouldn't say it tries to be. It's cute, the illustrations are well done, and it is really engaging and fun to read.

I'm a huge fan of Teagan White's illustrations, and I looooove the sweet ones included in this book (though I have to say the triceratops seemed oddly out of place). I enjoy looking at this book - even the endpapers are gorgeous - but my daughter has never really been a fan and it's definitely lacking as a means to learn/teach the alphabet.

The board book version is not the same. It's a dumbed down simplified version without the cute story of seasons and such. It's just another boring a is for apple type deal. Extremely disappointed. I'd been waiting for this book for weeks.

This book is simply adorable! I adore the illustrations in this book, as well as the way this story takes readers through the four season, while teaching readers their ABC's. Teagan White is an author/illustrator whom is now on my radar. I love that she created a children's ABC picture book that teaches kids their abc's by letter identification. Each word that begins with the letter being taught is a different color, so that it stands out for easy identification. For example, for C, she includes the words: catch, colds, can't, and each of those three words stands out among the other words on that page, so that children can easily identify those words. The illustrations that accompany each page are simply adorable! I love the charming woodland critters, and want to decorate my library with them. The inside flap of the hard cover book has a poster that can easily be framed and

hung up. I'm hoping Teagan White has an Esty shop, because I would seriously purchase some of her artwork, it's that adorable. I'm looking forward to reading more of her children's pictures book. This is a must have book! It's one that will make a great gift.

I pre-ordered for granddaughter in board book format, however it is not the usual 'laminated' finish of board books, feels like cardboard. It seems rather cheaply printed and doubt it will hold up to toddler/preschooler handling.

I got this book as a gift for a then-yet-unborn little girl. I ended up reading the book myself -- more times than I'd care to admit -- before I sent the gift. Then the expectant mother also confessed to reading the book several times. The illustrations and the midcentury color palette are delightful, and while we progress through the letters of the alphabet, we also move along the seasons with the sweet creatures and their friends. Can't wait for more from this illustrator!

This was a gift for my almost 4-year-old niece. She also loves dinosaurs, so the dinosaurs throughout the book were a fun bonus. :)
