

Rollo has often blogged that unplugging men from the Matrix is a dirty job. He compared it to triage: "Save the ones you can, read last rites to the dying". In my case, it was not dirty or difficult at all. I have unplugged all by myself over the past couple of years, I just couldn't fully grasp the new reality I found myself in. Picture Neo, who wakes up in his pod, after a struggle with agent Smith; Matrix reality nowhere to be seen. The machine which dumps him into the sewer has, fortunately, not yet arrived. I met my Morpheus (Rollo) when I was sitting upright in the pod, curiously looking around, trying to make sense of the rows and columns of dimly lit pods. I took the Red Pill, but the reality did not change for me, I only understood better what I was experiencing. I have previously, on my own, come to many of the same conclusions that the Red Pillers did, but not with the same level of details, clarity and with less first hand experience. This reality is better, for it is the truer one.

This book has been more enlightening to me as a young adult more than any life experiences I've ever had in the years since I've become a young adult. Tomassi doesn't sugar coat anything and gives the hard reality that underlies the problems, expectations, difficulties, trials and everything in-between men and women and how they relate to each other. It would be difficult to imagine that there is anything that he says in this book that is actually controversial, rather reactions against it are more due to the fact that almost everything he has to say isn't politically correct. Reading this might make you somewhat disillusioned about women if you're a guy like me who previously used to believe that men and women were equal with each other or that they should always be treated nicely in any and all situations. This entire book is nothing but an exposition about how female behavior manifests itself, and what this means if you happen to be a male. Some might view this more along the lines of a PUA book, and certainly almost everything he's written can be applied to that end in mind, but all of our behavior is oriented towards us getting what we want out of a certain set of circumstances. He expounds on notions of female hypergamy, and female solipsism, women's sexual market value, and useful guidelines for men to follow to avoid future mishaps and disasters that may arise in the course of a relationship.
