


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The Art Of Richard Thompson



Synopsis

Known for being the creator of the comic strip Cul de Sac, Richard Thompson's art prowess extends to many other levels. Richard Thompson is renowned among cartoonists as an "artist's" cartoonist. Little known to all but those close to him is the extent of his art talent. This is the book that will enlighten the rest of us and delight us with the sheer beauty of his work. Divided into six sections, each beginning with an introductory conversation between Thompson and six well-known peers, including Bill Watterson, the book will present Thompson's illustration work, caricatures, and his creation, Richard's Poor Almanack. Each section is highly illustrated, many works in color, most of them large and printed one-to-a-page. The diversity of work will help cast a wider net, well beyond Cul de Sac fans.

With a husband and daughter who speak Cul-de-Sac-ese (most often when they don't want me to understand what's going on), it can be easy to forget that Richard Thompson is both Cul de Sac and so much more. This book is beautiful- full of fantastic images and text that help all those who love Richard Thompson's art to see the larger breadth of his style and subject. It is a lovely book. It is also a very informative book--so much there on process, thinking, and the requirements of each type of art/illustration. We have recommended it to high school art classes as a resource because of its depth and the quality of the color plates. On a personal note, the characters from Cul de Sac are integrated into my family's daily take on life--as though they are cousins. Having memorized all of Richard Thompson's previous books, it was a wonderful surprise to be surprised by all art in this book.

Richard Thompson is a genius - no doubt - of imagination, of writing, and of drawing. Now that he can no longer draw, we have this compendium of art and drawings (both related to Cul de Sac and not). The book is divided into six sections, each one introduced with a conversation between Richard and various other comic art luminaries (from Bill Watterson onward). These conversations show Thompson in glorious light - with self-deprecating humor and the same sensibility seen in his work. It's easy to see why he is both loved and respected by his peers. A treat for anyone who loves drawing - and if you already know and love the man's work, you have to see this.

Finally, a book that lets the world know Richard Thompson's art consists of so much more than Cul de Sac, beloved and wonderful though it was. The art amassed here is stunning, and the insights from cartoonist friends of the "cartoonist's cartoonist" are rich, funny and touching.
