If youre a simpleton who is incapable of critical thought-then this book is for you. The authors offer their opinion in a dogmatic fashion-typical of doctors who have an uncritical committment to their profession. No wonder pain care in America isn't evolving for books like this one assume a simple and reductionistic approach to pain care. The authors make no note of the reproducibility crises- so the facts they refer to are quite questionable- as their is suppressed evidence in pain care due to publication bias.
