


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Forty Studies That Changed Psychology (7th Edition)

He is coauthor (with Meg Kennedy Dugan) of, It's My Life Now: Starting over after an Abusive Relationship or Domestic Violence. He brings over 20 years of teaching experience to the project.

research in their different editions. This is important to note if you're looking to save money on buying an older edition. Don't. The research will be a little different.
