

Very interesting book for jigs and shop aids.I've found unless your doing something "special" or a lot of one item, it is a lot of work and money to build jigs you might only use once.In some cases, it takes more time (and material) to build the jig then the end project the jig will be used for.Then you have to store them in case you ever need them again.I've built several, for projects I've worked on that were a great help.
