

Make use of other innovative materials, too, including soluble canvas which allows you to cross stitch on any fabric and glow in the dark embroidery floss. Hannah's designs are a little bit different from what is available elsewhere. She uses simple outlines with striking patterns and clean, fresh colors, and takes inspiration from new interior fashions, vintage textiles, nature, toys, and more, always striving to be contemporary and stylish.

Children's Charity. No other job title was ever going to match that so after having two children, Wilfred and Olive (or Bobo as she is fondly known), she listened again to the call of cross stitch. She started designing her own contemporary patterns and in 2013, her company Bobo Stitch was born. Hannah is now the proud purveyor of cross stitch kits and a joyous embracer of the modern craft revolution. She lives in southwest London, UK, with her husband, children, and a ridiculously large stash of embroidery floss.

Just what I have been waiting for-I used to love cross stitch but I fell out of love with the designs so stopped for a while. A friend recommended this to me and it has totally reignited my passion! Stylish, up to date designs with clever twists like glow in the dark thread. Really clear patterns (printed nice and large so you can stitch straight from the book) and good instructions too which was helpful where I felt a bit rusty. Most of the designs aren't complicated so you can just relax and stitch something pretty. Would definitely recommend.

Not a very interesting MODERN take on cross stitch. I found most designs boring (except for the featured cover). Honestly the only pattern worth admiration. I would not recommend purchase or recommend to fellow x-stitchers.
